CCP Facilitator Training in San Diego – coming fall 2010

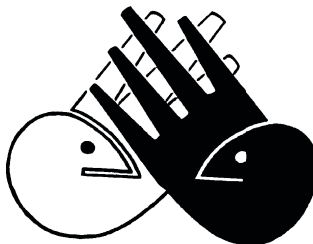
