## TWO WAYS YOU CAN HELP:

**1. Volunteer** for a day to help construct the new Friends Center, an exciting project that combines environmentalism, peace activism and social justice organizing. The Friends Center is a collaborative project between the Peace Resource Center, Church of the Brethren, San Diego Friends Meeting (Quakers) and American Friends Service Committee. The environmentally friendly, energy-efficient building will house the PRC, Friends Meeting and AFSC U.S.-Mexico Border Project and also provide meeting space for other community organizations and projects. Join us to work on the inside walls and landscaping. No skills required, training will be provided.

**2. Sponsor** a volunteer worker. Your donation as a sponsor will give encouragement to those donating their labor and also benefit two peace groups: the Project on Youth and Non-Military Opportunities (Project YANO) and the Peace Resource Center of San Diego (see below).

**WORK-A-THON VOLUNTEERS** – On June 30, volunteers will do light construction tasks including inside wall framing (mostly with screwguns), assorted maintenance tasks, and outside planting, mulching and replacement planting in permaculture landscape areas. Location: City Heights, San Diego. Time frame: 9 am to mid-afternoon (people can work all or part of this). Workers are asked to solicit sponsorships from family members, friends, employers, etc., to match their contribution of labor with a donation. To volunteer as a worker, please complete and return the bottom coupon now and an information packet will be sent to you. You should begin collecting sponsorships right away using the form on the back of this flier to record sponsors' names and contributions/pledges.

**WORK-A-THON SPONSORS** – Sponsors contribute money in support of a volunteer worker. You can sponsor a specific worker whom you know, or fill out the coupon below and we'll match your sponsorship with a volunteer. Financial contributions are tax-deductible. ### ■ *The Project on Youth and Non-Military Opportunities (Project YANO)*

Project YANO sends military veterans into local high schools to counter the presence of military recruiters and present alternatives for job training, community service and college financial aid. Project YANO encourages young people to become active in efforts to solve community and global problems and to consider careers in peacemaking and social change. Project YANO also provides training and resources to counter recruitment nationally.

### ■ *The Peace Resource Center of San Diego*

The Peace Resource Center, formed in 1979, works to promote peace and social justice by nonviolent means through a variety of community programs and activities. The PRC also provides resources and serves as a clearing-house for groups and individuals on peace and social justice issues.
