Peter "Pete" Seeger (May 3, 1919 – January 27, 2014) was an American folk singer and activist. A fixture on nationwide radio, he also had a string of hit records. He became a prominent singer of protest music in support of international disarmament, civil rights, Labor right, and environmental causes.

A prolific songwriter, his best-known song collaborations include "Where Have All the Flowers Gone?", "If I Had a Hammer" and "Turn! Turn! Turn!" and many more.
